Abstracts must be no longer than one side of A4, including diagrams or charts. Please use Arial 11 point and set the margins to 2.5cm at each side, top and bottom.

The area for display on the poster boards is 2m high x 1m wide (**portrait**) and posters must be kept within these boundaries. The poster should identify the title of the paper, the authors and their affiliations across the top. Text should be legible from 3ft and drawings and charts kept simple. Posters are fixed to the boards by Velcro fastenings, which will be supplied.

All posters, appropriately submitted, will be displayed.
